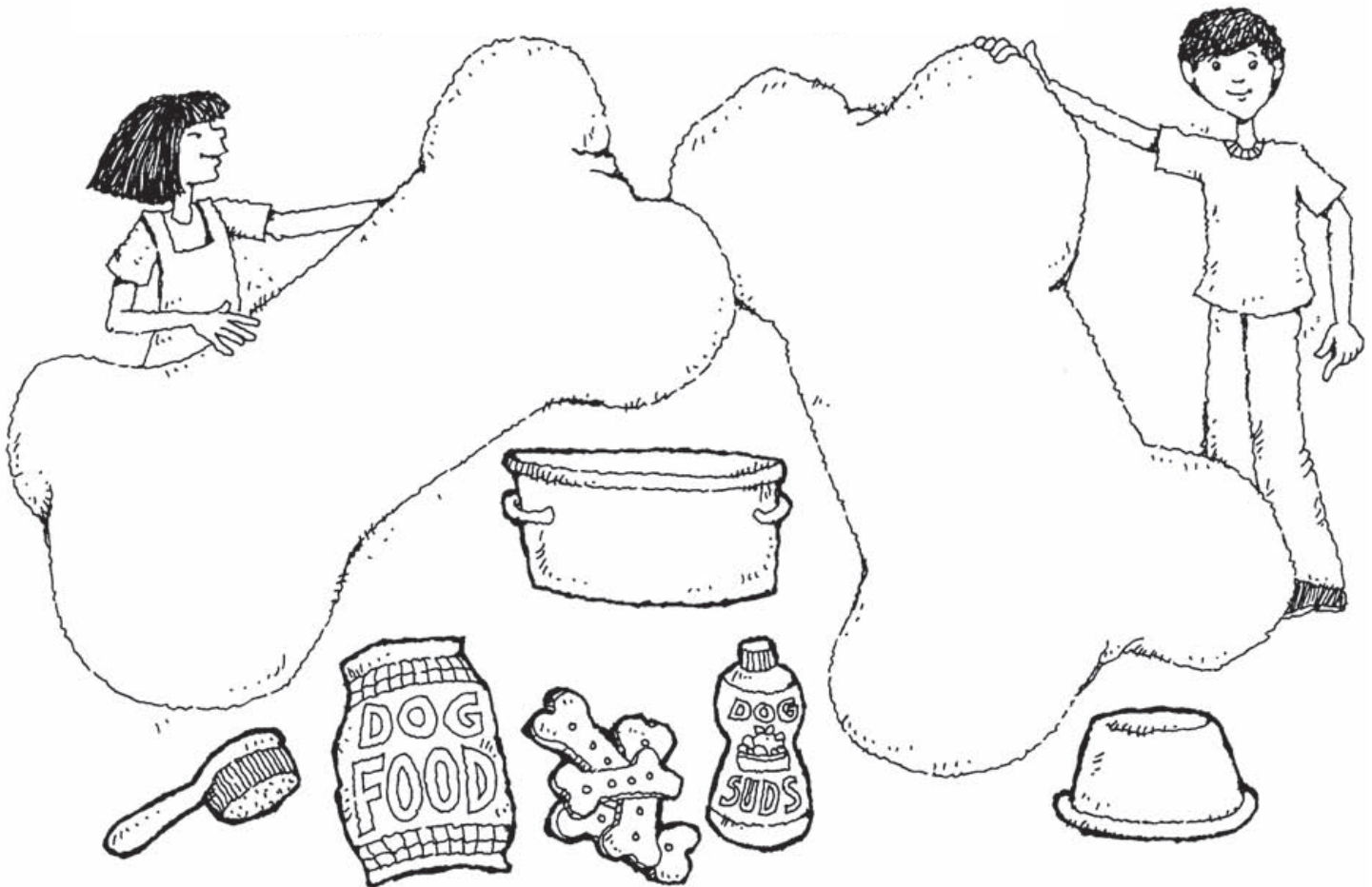
Taking Care of Fifi
