




What is your name?








Cut out the squares. Arrange the squares from largest to smallest and from smallest to largest. Identify the colors. Name the shape.



Cut out the triangles, squares, and rectangles below. The student is to glue them on a separate sheet of paper to make a house and trees as seen below.











Cut out the template below. The student will use this to learn how to set the table.



Cut out the picture and the stars. Glue the stars on the picture in the night sky.











Cut out the signs and fold the tabs underneath so the signs stand up. The student will place these on the floor and follow them as they drive toy cars.












Cut out the cards. Match the animals which are the same. Play a memory game with the cards turned over.


Cut out the cards below. Match the times to morning, afternoon, and night. Some times will apply to more than one picture.
