


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# KINDERGARTEN FAVORITES COMPREHENSION GUIDE

## *How to Use this Guide*

What is *Kindergarten Favorites*? It is a collection of literature guides to assist beginning readers to enjoy and comprehend a book. Once children learn how to decode words, they need to learn how to engage the materials. They need to learn how to comprehend what they are reading. So how do we do this?

The books may be read in any order, but we have placed them in order based on difficulty. Generally, we spend three to four days per book. Children generally will read the book twice during this time. They should be reading the books aloud with you. You should help them to decode unfamiliar words. Be sure to let children sound out the words, rather than just giving them the pronunciation. Teach them to read with expression, which includes following the punctuation.

The comprehension questions and activities are there to help children focus on particular portions of the text and to help you assess their understanding of it. The children should be allowed to refer back to the text if needed.

The activities are meant to bring the text alive. Children always retain more when they work with the material. Handwriting exercises will provide students practice sentences to rehearse manuscript writing.

*How about making homemade dog biscuits for your own dog or a friend's dog? Made with cheese (a favorite with dogs) and garlic (a natural flea repellent), they'll quickly become your dog's favorite, paws down.*

### *Ingredients*

1 1/4 cups of grated Cheddar cheese

1/4 pound of softened  
corn oil margarine


1 1/2 cups of whole wheat flour

1 crushed garlic clove

milk

### *Directions*

To make a batch, combine the dry ingredients. Mix well. Add enough milk to form the dough into a ball, then cover the ball with plastic wrap and chill for 30 minutes. On a floured board, roll out the dough to a 1/2-inch thickness. Cut out bone shapes and bake on an ungreased baking sheet at 375 degrees for 15 minutes or until slightly brown and firm. Makes 2 to 3 dozen, depending on size.





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
