Playing Three Black Keys

When playing the three black keys, remember to play loud for f and soft for p.





Using LH fingers 2, 3, and 4, play three black keys **low** on the keyboard at once. Play the three keys softly (\boldsymbol{p}) on each word as you say,

"I can play three low black keys."







Using RH fingers 2, 3, and 4, play three black keys **high** on the keyboard at once. Play the three keys loudly (f) on each word as you say,

"I can play three high black keys."



Using fingers 2, 3, and 4 of either hand, play **all** the three-black-key groups on the entire keyboard.


A whole note Count: 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 gets four counts. It is as long as two half notes or four quarter notes.







A whole rest gets four counts. Rest for the whole measure.
