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### Vivid Verbs

A verb expresses action or state of being. A **vivid verb** paints a mental picture for the reader. It has a more specific meaning than a <u>common verb</u> which is used all of the time.

Rather than using the common verb, walk, use a vivid verb.

#### **Common Verbs**

The dog <u>walked</u> around the trees.

The man <u>walked</u> slowly through the neighborhood.

#### **Vivid Verbs**

The dog **meandered** around the trees. The man **strolled** through the neighborhood.
