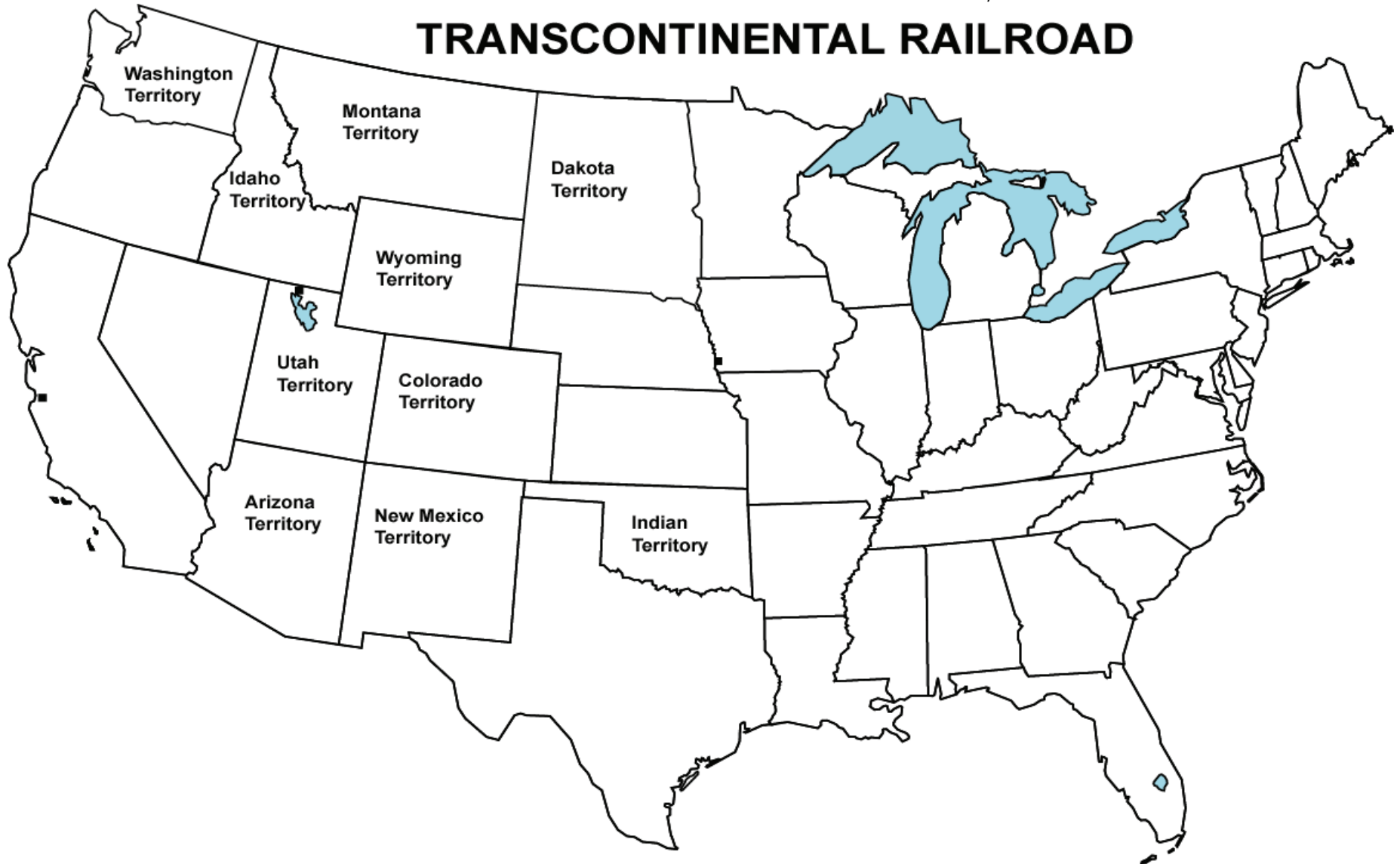


TRANSCONTINENTAL RAILROAD



- Label the 38 states that were part of the UNITED STATES in 1868.
- Label the bodies of water including the Great Lakes.
- Railroads were everywhere from Maine to Florida and as far west as Kansas. Circle KANSAS in red. This was as far as anyone could travel on the railroad.
- The Transcontinental Railroad began in two places; OMAHA, NEBRASKA and SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA. Label these places on the map (black dots).
- The railroad met at Promontory Summit, Utah. Label this on the map (black dot).

CHALLENGE: What is the name of the body of water located in Utah?

GEOGRAPHY NEED TO KNOW: Arkansas' location on the U.S. Map and its capital (Little Rock).
