

LATCH-A-LOOP PILLOW KIT



1. DESIGN YOUR PATTERN

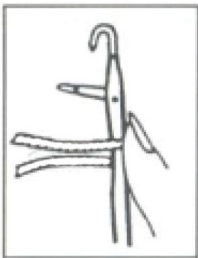
Plan the design for your pillow. Note, the mesh has 44 horizontal spaces and 35 vertical spaces and your kit includes 220 of each color of fabric strip. You can follow the single-stripe design pictured, choose a pattern from the Design Guide or create your own look. Let your personal style be your guide!

2. PREPARE YOUR MESH

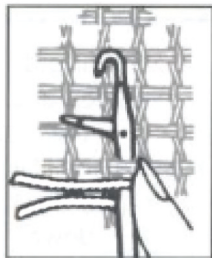
You will need to leave a 1" border of mesh on all sides in order to attach your backing later. Before you begin the latch hook process, measure and mark a 1" border on all sides of the mesh.

3. LATCH YOUR LOOPS

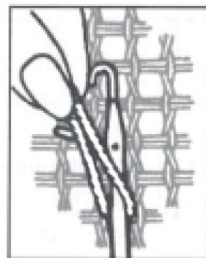
Our latch-a-loop process works just like regular latch hooking. Follow the simple steps below to attach each fabric strip. **NOTE:** The fabric strips can vary slightly in thickness and some might be a little harder to pull through. A firm tug usually does the trick but if you encounter a lot of resistance, pull the strips tighter around the latch hook tool before inserting through the mesh.



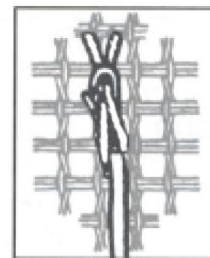
1. Hold the latch hook in your right hand and the fabric strip in your left. Place the strip around the tool just below the latch with even lengths of fabric on both sides. Hold the strip in place with your right index finger.



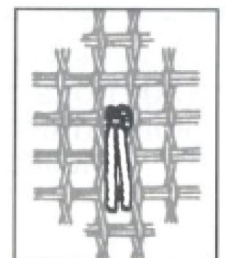
2. Insert the tip of the hook into a hole in the mesh and then out the hole directly above. Push the hook through past the latch.



3. Grasp both ends of the strip using your left thumb and left index finger. Make sure the latch is open. Place the strip between the latch and the hook.



4. Pull the hook towards you until the latch closes. Let go of the strip and continue pulling to complete a loop around the mesh.



5. Tighten the loop by pulling both ends of the strip toward you.

4. ASSEMBLE YOUR PILLOW

Once you've attached all of your strips and completed the latch-a-loop process, prepare to assemble your pillow. Place the pillow on your work surface with the mesh side face up. Place the batting on top of the mesh. Fold in the 1" border and place the fleece material over the batting and mesh border. Attach the fleece by tying each fleece fringe to a latched strip.

5. ENJOY!

Your pillow is the perfect size to accent your bed or chair and to pack for your next sleepover!

Care instructions: spot clean once assembled.
