Sometimes you feel happy.

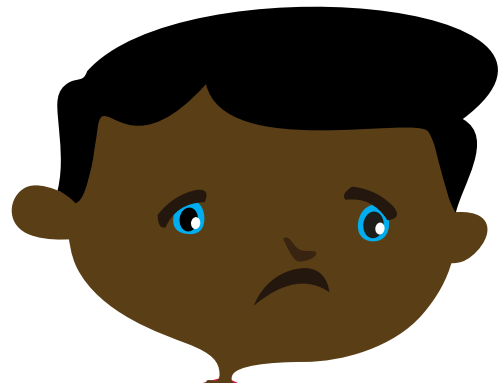

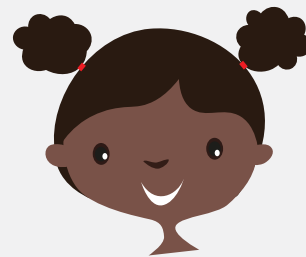

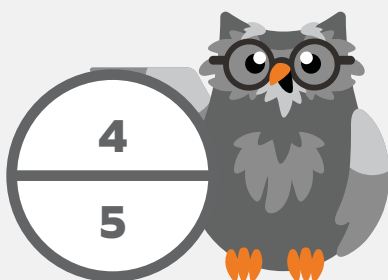
