Expected Student Outcomes

KNOW

Samuel anoints Israel's first two kings.

DO

Students will:

- cut out pictures of Saul and David and use them to review the Bible truth
- circle pictures showing good choices being made
- color a hidden picture and complete a sentence to learn that God looks at the heart of each person
- trace words that indicate the right choices David made before Samuel anointed him as king

APPLY

Students will contrast obedience and disobedience and choose to obey.

TEACHER'S HEART

There is an old saying that you can't judge a book by its cover, meaning that the outside of something does not always give an adequate picture of what is on the inside. How true this was for King David and King Saul! Saul was a tall, handsome man who appeared to be an excellent choice for a king; yet on the inside, his heart was not completely devoted to God. David, on the other hand, was a very young man who did not appear to be a good choice to lead a nation. However, David was fully devoted to God. He was a man after God's own heart.

It is important that you do not place too much value on appearances, especially when it comes to your students. Many times, the child who does not appear to be paying attention is the same one who has heard every word. Students who seem unable to keep track of a pencil are often very creative people. Frequently, the quietest children are the deepest thinkers. Praise God that each child in your class is a precious individual!
