

Size and Alignment

Size and alignment refer to the evenness of the letters along the bottom line and along their tops, with all letters of the same size even in height.

Line quality is the smoothness, evenness, color,

Maximum letters fill almost the entire space.

Maximum Size Letters

Minimum letters fill approximately one-half of the writing space.


Descenders fill approximately one-half the space below the bottom line.


Intermediate letters **d** and **t** fill approximately two-thirds of the writing space.

Intermediate Size Letters




Good Posture

Cursive Paper Position

The position of your paper or book is important for maintaining consistent slant in your writing. It also helps with the overall legibility of your handwriting.



Spacing

Correct spacing between letters, words, and sentences makes your writing easy to read. Study the spacing examples below.

Letter Forms

Cursive letters can be grouped in families based on stroke similarities. Study the groupings below.

Upper-Loop Letters Be sure to keep the upper-loop open in these letters. The undercurve leading into the upper loop of the letters must be made wide to allow room for the curve back and slant.

Checkstroke Letters The lowercase letters **b**, **v**, **o**, and **w** are checkstroke-ending letters. Special attention is needed when joining these letters to another letter. Study the examples below.

of the letter r.

- the loop of the letter e.
