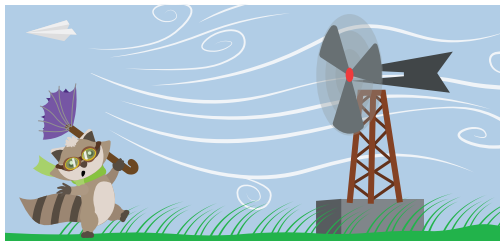

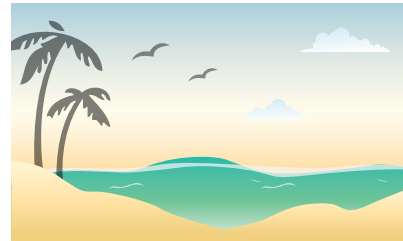

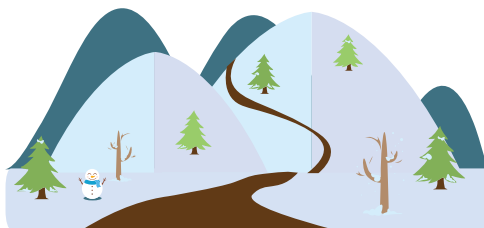

Your nose can smell good things. It can smell flowers.

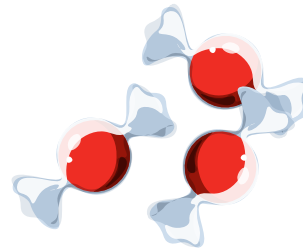
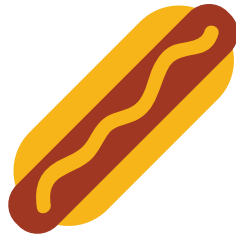
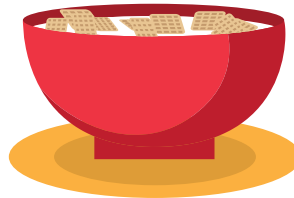
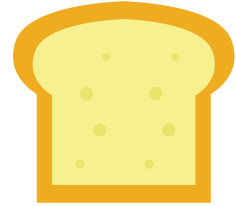
Your nose can smell bad things. Some things make the air smell bad. They are called pollution.

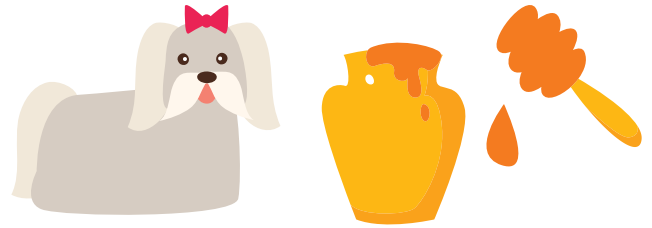

## You Feel

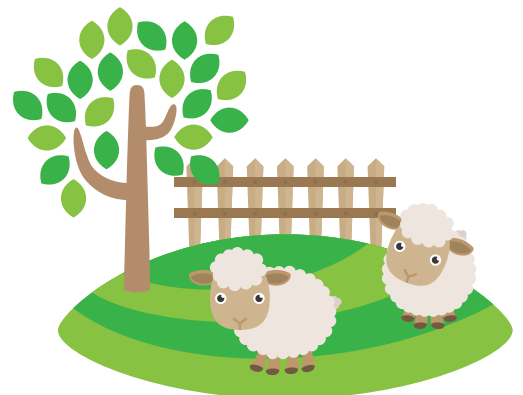
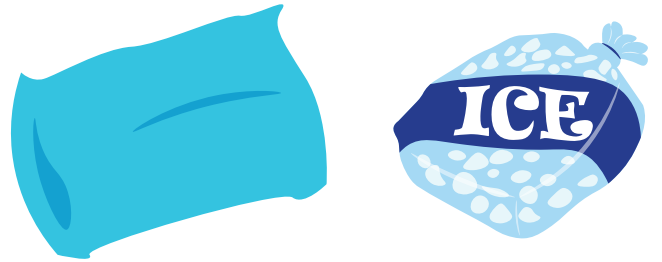
You can observe by touching.

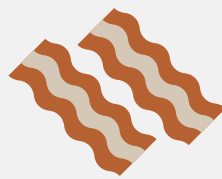
