

## Renaissance/Reformation

Comprehensive spines, which provide thorough narrative coverage of the entire period:

Gr. 3-8 \*Island Story, by H.E. Marshall This covers England's history, a focus of study during the Ren/Ref. \*Story of the Renaissance and Reformation, by Christine Miller & H.A. Guerber Gr. 4-8 This can serve students through Grade 12 because the coverage is thorough and it is easy to find/purchase. Renaissance and Reformation Times, by Dorothy Mills Gr. 6-12 \*Story of Liberty, by Charles Coffin Gr. 6-12 Very important ideas are shared in this book.

General resources, which either 1) cover world history by making key points about multiple periods or by offering a brief summary of each, or 2) discuss selected events of significance in the period:

\*Light and the Glory for Children, by Peter Marshall & David Manuel Gr. 1-5 Some enjoy this book's attempt to see God's hand in U.S. history; others do not. Only the chapter on Columbus is cited in this guide; the remaining chapters will be cited in succeeding TruthQuest History guides.

\*Story of the World: Volume 2 & 3, by Susan Wise Bauer Gr. 3-6

\*Story of the Thirteen Colonies, by H.A. Guerber Gr. 3-7

This covers United States history, so only early chapters on exploration are cited here. Listed as a 'comprehensive spine' in succeeding TruthQuest History guides, when US history is a key focus.

\*Greenleaf's Famous Men of the Renaissance & Reformation, by R. Shearer Gr. 3-8 Collection of brief biographies, some on persons rarely covered elsewhere.

\*This Country of Ours, by H.E. Marshall Gr. 3-8

This covers United States history, so only early chapters on exploration are cited here. Listed as a 'comprehensive spine' in succeeding TruthQuest History guides, when US history is a key focus.

\*Trial and Triumph: Stories from Church History, by Richard Hannula Gr. 5-12 \*Light and the Glory, by Peter Marshall & David Manuel Gr. 6-12

Some families greatly enjoy books by Peter Marshall; others do not. Only the chapters on Columbus are cited in this guide; remaining chapters will be cited in succeeding TruthQuest History guides.

\*How Should We Then Live? by Francis Schaeffer [book or video format] Gr. 9-12 One of the most important resources you will ever use! Highly significant and highly recommended!
