Uncle Deckle and the Maple Apples

BEFORE YOU READ: *(All SnapWords® resources are available at child1st.com)*

SOUND SPELLINGS: /L/ spelled LE. Words with LE endings: UNCLE, DECKLE, MAPLE, CATTLE, TABLE, RAFFLE, APPLE, SAMPLE, HUDDLE, CABLE, HANDLE, BUCKLE, RATTLE, WOBBLE, TACKLE, TROUBLE, TOPPLE, GRUMBLE. Apart from the LE endings, please point out that many of the words have a double consonant in the middle before the LE ending. All of those words have a short vowel sound before the double letter: “cattle, raffle, apple, huddle, rattle, wobble, topple.” There are other words which have two consonants, but they are not a double consonant. The vowels in those words are also short: “uncle, Deckle, sample, handle, buckle, tackle, grumble.” As you make columns with these words, please underline the double consonant so they stand out for the students. Finally, there are words with Long vowel sounds and only one additional consonant before the LE: “maple, table, cable.

SIGHT WORDS: D Words: ALWAYS, UPON. G Words: MAIN, THAT’S. UPON can be easily sounded out as a simple compound word. ALWAYS would be ALL and WAYS but one L in ALL is dropped. The AY spelling is similar to these words: “plays, lays, sprays, trays, ways”. MAIN has a long A spelling (Ai) that it shares with: “pain, nail, mail, sail, tail, bain, train, plain.” THAT’S is a contraction of two words: “that” and “is.”

READ: Please follow reading tips as outlined in Book 1 in this section.

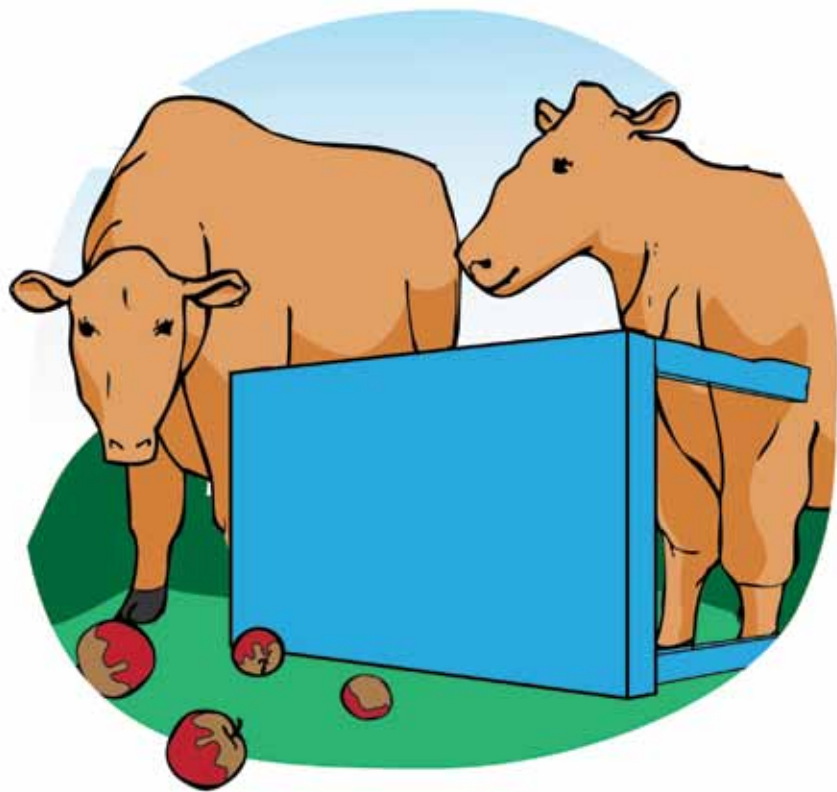
COMPREHENSION QUESTIONS:

1. What is always in the middle of Uncle Deckle’s fair?
2. What are some things Uncle Deckle has on tables at the fair?

4. How did Uncle Deckle help?
