
- 3. Write a whole note BELOW the given note to make the indicated harmonic interval.
- 4. Write the names of the notes in the squares below the staff. Write the name of the lower note in the lower square; the name of the higher note in the higher square.








2. Write the notes of the D MAJOR SCALE in the BASS staff over the squares. Use WHOLE NOTES.
