






# MARBLE CIRCUIT™

## Rules

### Includes:



- 1 game board
- 1 gate 
- 10 tiles
  - 3 split tiles 
  - 3 cross-over tiles 
  - 2 right exit tiles 
  - 2 left exit tiles 
- 8 steel marbles
- 64 challenge cards
- 1 reference card

### Object:

Correctly place the tiles so the number of marbles that collect in the five targets match the challenge card.

### Set up:

Slide the gate into the channel at the top of the board. Place one marble at the top of each track behind the gate.

### Playing the game:

Choose a challenge card and place the starting tiles on the board as indicated on the card. Note that starting tiles are shown in color on the card. Also note the numbers in the target spaces on the card. These numbers indicate the number of marbles that should end in these spaces.

Predict the paths of the marbles and place the remaining mystery tiles on the board.

Slowly slide the gate to the right to release the marbles.

**Note:** Releasing the marbles all at once can cause the marbles to collide or get stuck causing marbles to land in the wrong target spaces.

If tiles are placed correctly, the number of marbles in the target spaces will match the numbers shown on the card. If not, re-arrange the mystery tiles, reset the marbles, and try again.

**Note:** Beginner puzzles show more starting tiles with fewer paths to predict. Puzzle cards increase in difficulty as fewer starting tiles are shown.
