Page 147, #1C, Teacher's Edition	"Never" is incorrectly labeled as an adjective.	Should be: adv
Chapter 8 Teacher's Edition page N, #1A	"You" is labeled as the helping verb and "are" is labeled as the subject—these are backward.	Switch the labels: "S" goes above "you" and "HV" goes above "are."
Page 246	The definition for "verb phrase" is incomplete.	Change to: A helping verb together with either an action verb or a linking verb.
