







A is for **Answers** from God's Holy Book; Just open the pages and take a good look. God created the earth, in space it did hang; Creation's first day, without a BIG BANG.



B is for Bible, where it says on day 2, God made the clean air for me and for you. He divided the waters above and below; Day 3 comes next, so there we shall go.




C is for Continent, the first dry land, Which God had made by His Powerful hand. Then He commanded that all the plants grow; The third day was truly a beautiful show.




