"Look at all those zillions of stars!" said God. "One day you will have a son, and from him will follow zillions more families, as many as the stars. I promise."

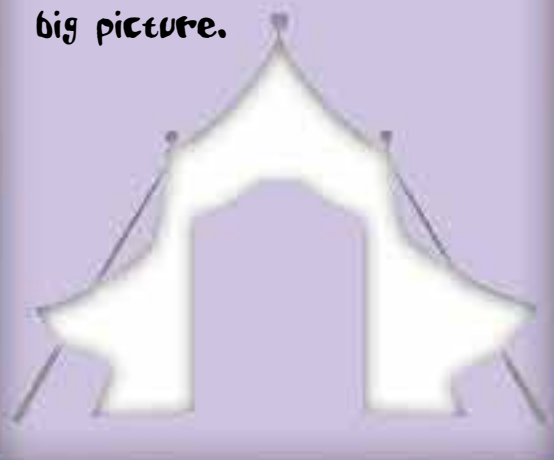
One day, three messengers from God appeared. "This time next year, you will have a baby," they said.

“It’s deep and wide. How will we get across it?” everyone asked.

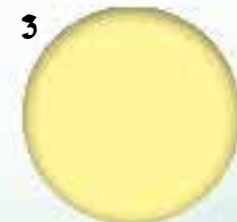
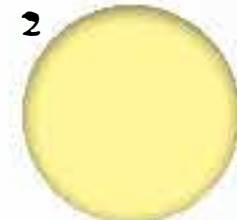
But God made it possible for them to cross the water. Moses lifted a special wooden stick, and the wind blew the waves back so all the people could cross safely on the path through the sea.

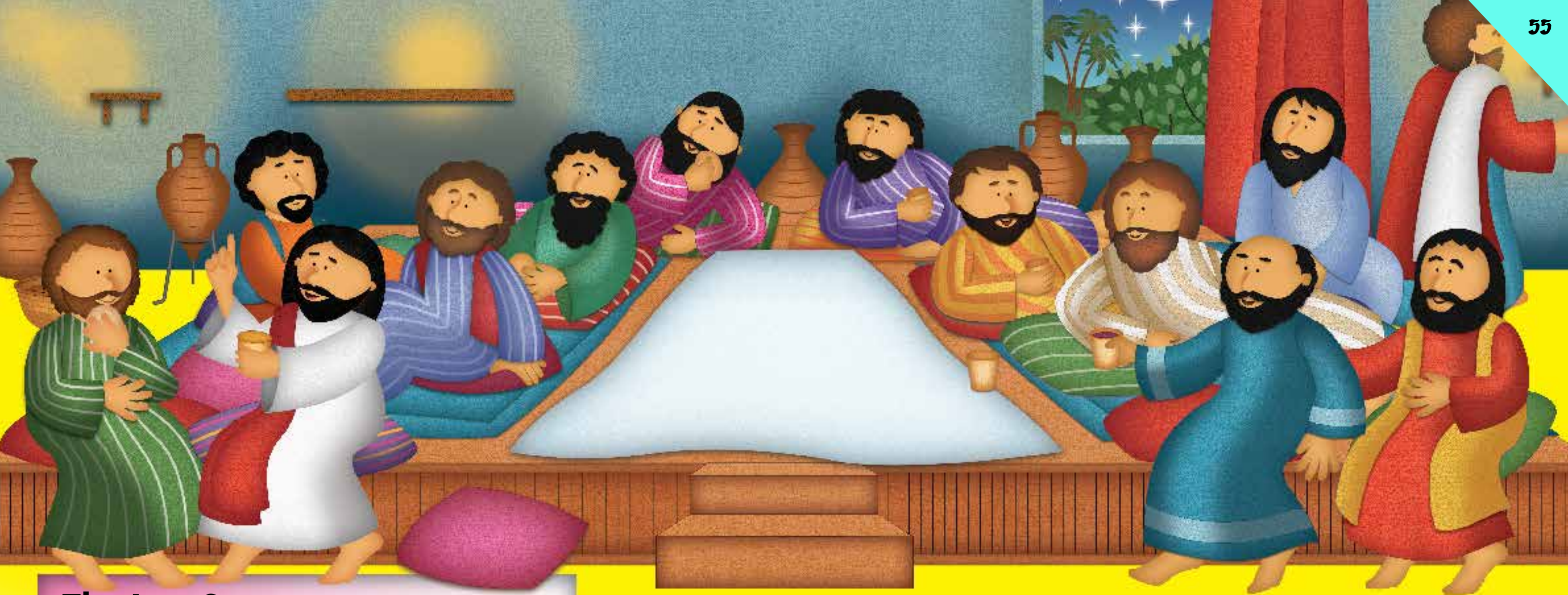

Jesus knew that one of His friends was planning something very, very bad. "Soon one of you will give Me away to My enemies," He said.

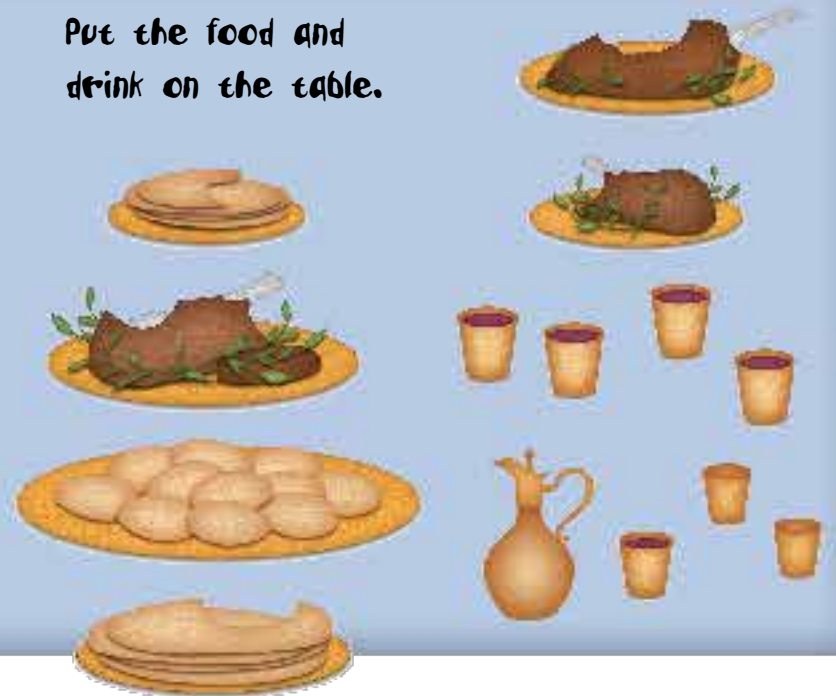
His disciples shook their heads. "I would never do such a thing!" said Peter. "None of us would!"

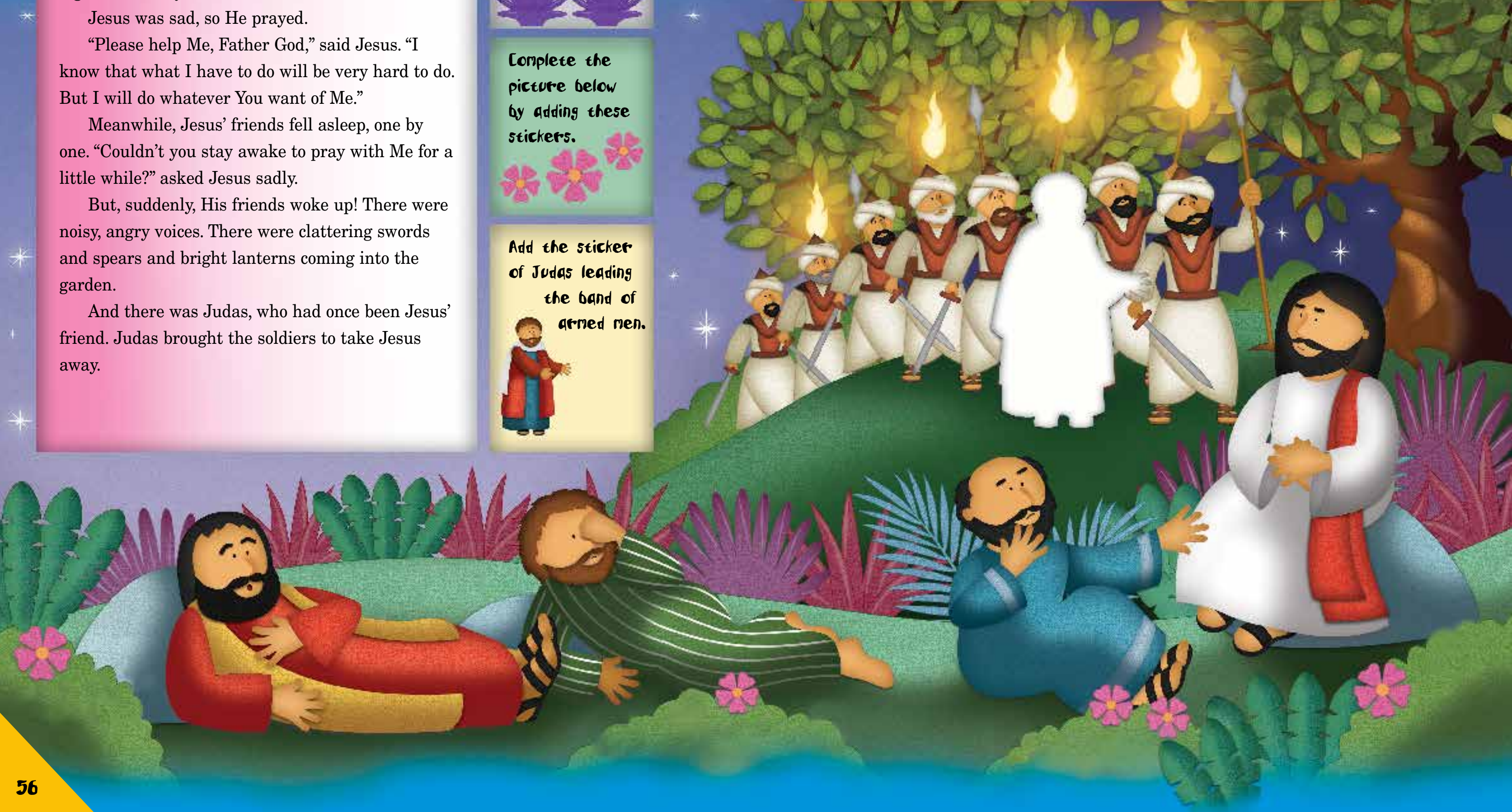
