Playing Two Black Keys

Symbols that show how loud or soft to play are called *dynamics*. These symbols come from Italian words.

Loud Sounds

f

The sign f stands for **forte**, which means to play **loud**.

Using LH fingers 2 and 3, play two black keys **low** on the keyboard at once. Play the two keys loudly (f) on each word as you say,

"I can play two low black keys."







Soft Sounds



The sign \boldsymbol{p} stands for \boldsymbol{piano} , which means to play \boldsymbol{soft} .

Using RH fingers 2 and 3, play two black keys **high** on the keyboard at once. Play the two keys softly (p) on each word as you say,

"I can play two high black keys."









Using fingers 2 and 3 of either hand, play **all** the two-black-key groups on the entire keyboard.




Middle C Position
