

- On the left-side map, label ENGLAND and SCOTLAND. On both maps, label the ATLANTIC OCEAN and color blue the bodies of water.
- The Pilgrims' first move was from ENGLAND to LEIDEN, HOLLAND. Label the red dot on the left-side map LEIDEN.
- When the Pilgrims decided to establish their own colony in NORTH AMERICA, they sailed through the Strait of Dover from LEIDEN to SOUTHHAMPTON, ENGLAND. Draw a line from LEIDEN to SOUTHHAMPTON.
- Uh-oh, Speedwell is leaking again! Better go back to DARTMOUTH, ENGLAND for repairs. Draw a line from SOUTHHAMPTON out into the ATLANTIC OCEAN, then back to DARTMOUTH, and finally off the left edge of the left-side map toward NORTH AMERICA.
- Draw *Mayflower* arriving alone on the right edge of the right-side map. Draw a dotted line from *Mayflower* to her first landing place at PROVIDENCETOWN HARBOR.
- Trace the Pilgrims' path across Cape Cod Bay to their first permanent settlement in New England, PLYMOUTH. Label the green dot on the right-side map PLYMOUTH.
