It's a cookie party, with dozens of freshly baked shapes to explore! Here are three fun games to play with these yummy treats!

Game 1 – The youngest player goes first. Place all cookies in a pile. Spin the spinner. If the spinner lands on a shape, take that shape. If it lands on the cookie jar, put one cookie back in the jar. Try to collect all the different shapes!

Game 2 – The youngest player goes first. Place all cookies in a pile and spin.

If the spinner lands on a shape, the player must call out the name of the shape, and name another object that has the same shape. For example, if the spinner lands on a circle, players can call out "the moon" or "a wheel." If you guess correctly, take one cookie shape.
