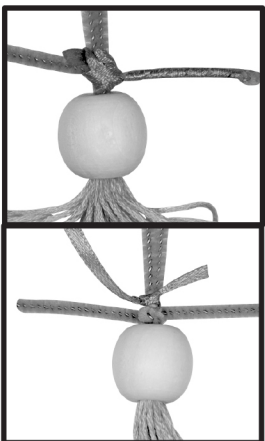

3. Find the center of the small pipe cleaner and bend it around the large pipe cleaner a little under the head, which makes the fairies arms.



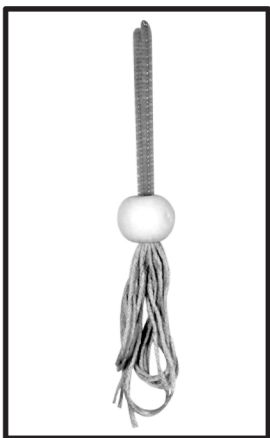
4. Tie one end of the colored ribbon around the body of the fairy. Wind the ribbon around where the pipe cleaners meet and out the length of the arm. Fold the tip of the pipe cleaner over the ribbon to help keep it in place. Wrap back to the center of the fairy then wrap the other arm.



1. Select 2 pieces of thread. Fold them in half, and repeat this step 2 more times. Fold the long pipe cleaner over the center and twist once.



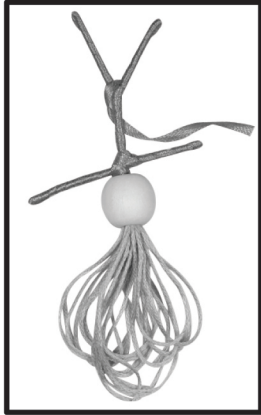
2. Slide the bead through the pipe cleaner ends as shown. The bead should just cover the folded part.



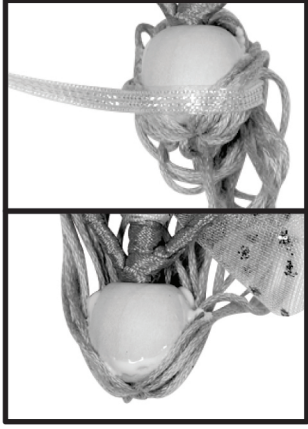
7. To dress her up, slide the fairies legs into the center of the fabric circles and flower. Use a piece of the sticky ribbon to hold the skirt tight around the fairies body. Wrap another piece below the skirt to keep it in place.



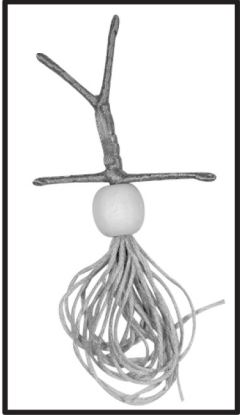
5. Wrap the body of the fairy down to where you'd like her legs to start. Wrap each part of the pipe cleaner separately to create the legs. Go down one leg, fold the tip of the pipe cleaner over the ribbon to hold it, and wrap back up to the body. Then wrap the other leg in the same way.



8. To style the fairies hair, smear some glue around the bead and push the thread down on it. Allow it to dry. Bunch the hair together to give her an up-do, pony tail, or pig tails. Use the sticky ribbon to hold it in place.



6. Wrap up the body and tie the end of the ribbon. Put a dab of glue over the knot and the end of the ribbon, let it dry.



10. Draw a cute little fairy face on the bead with the marker included.



11. Use a piece of sticky foam to attach the fairy wings to the back of the fairy.



12. Add glitter gel to the wings, your fairies clothes or anywhere you'd like to add some sweet sparkle.



\*Use the clear cord to hang your fairies around your room.
