Talk about art and art history with your students! The 8 designs on this paper were loosely inspired by the Paleolithic art found in the Lascaux Caves. The edges of each sheet are cut to resemble the rough edges of natural stone.

Dinosaurs and humans lived approximately 65 million years apart, but it's fun to imagine what life might have been like if humans and dinosaurs lived at the same time. Use this stone age stationery to imagine living with dinosaurs yourself!

Ideas: Create your own cave paintings on the back side of our double sided paper, or add your own artistic elements to the printed designs with markers or crayons.

You don't need a chisel to write on the back of our "stone tablets." Provide students with a prompt or story starter and ask them to write their story on the back of these sheets. Use the images to jump start your imagination!
