around you.



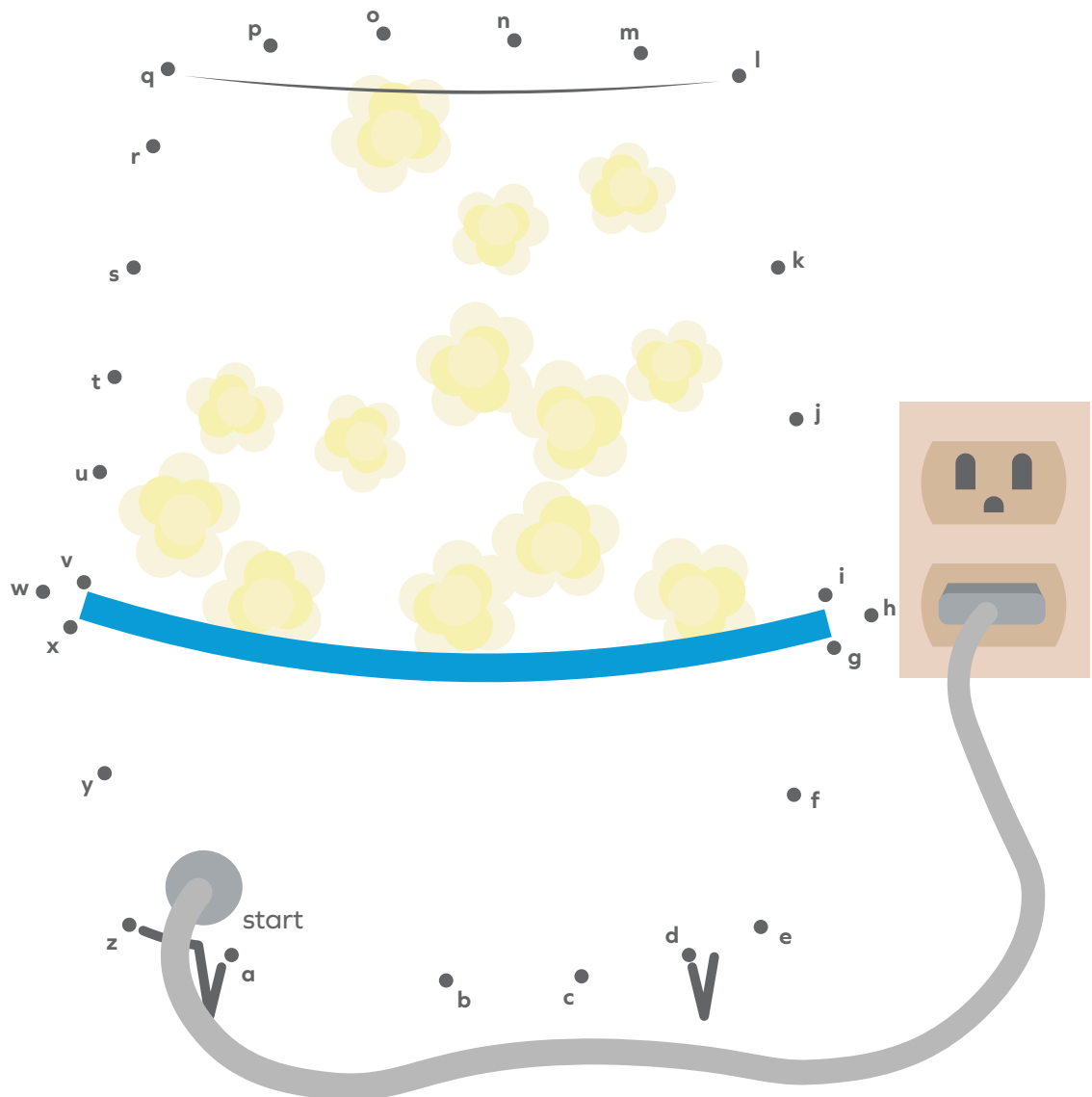

Your voice can make music.

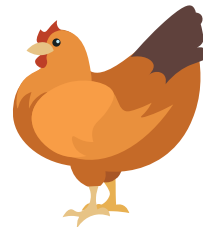
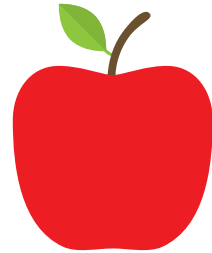

Your nose can smell good things. It can smell flowers.

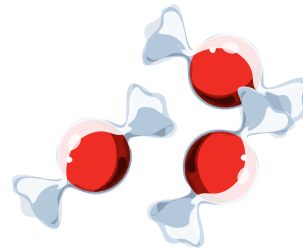
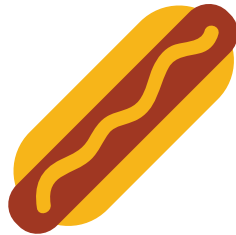
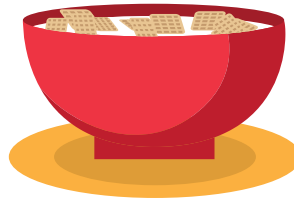
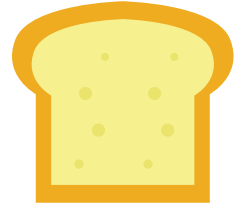
Your nose can smell bad things. Some things make the air smell bad. They are called pollution.

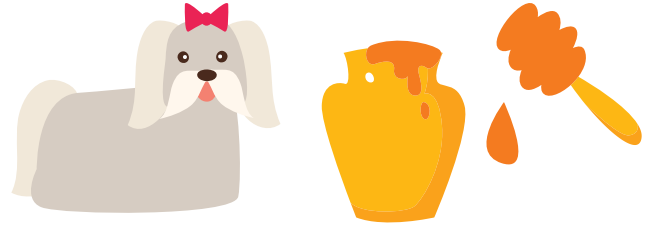

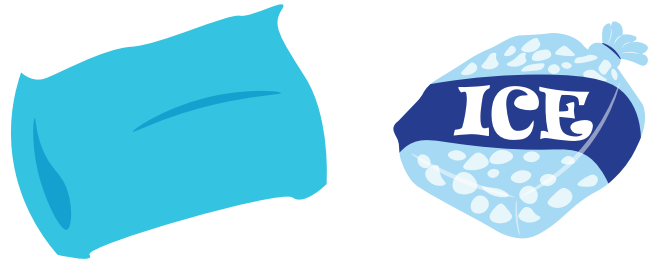
You Feel

by finding out how they feel.

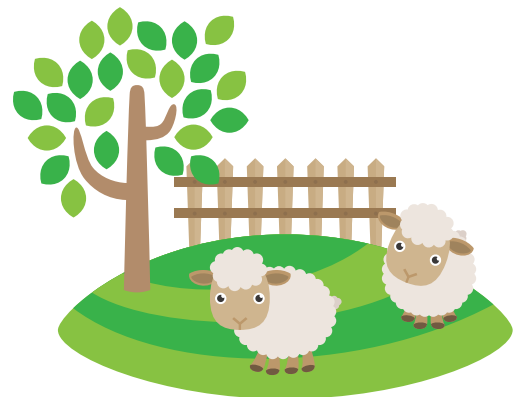


Feelings
