



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


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How To Use the Textbook

Start by reading each lesson to your student; then have him write the answers to the questions on a separate sheet of paper or say them orally. At the end of each lesson you will find at least one activity, which will reinforce the lesson. Most of the activities can be found in this *Activity Book*. The activities are quite varied, sometimes involving coloring, cutting, building, writing, etc. There are also additional activities included with each lesson, depending on how much time one has and the interest level of the student.



All lessons have a recurring activity under **Something Else To Do** that uses the Bible verses found at the beginning of each lesson. Each lesson contains a Bible verse with some words in bold-faced type. The student may memorize those parts of the verse in bold-faced type. The Bible verses are also found at the back of this *Activity Book* beginning on page 93 and can be removed.

A suggestion for the memorization of the verses is to punch a hole in the upper left-hand corner of each verse card and put a metal ring about an inch in diameter through it. Subsequent verses can then be added to the ring so that the student has them all together for further review.



Some lessons also contain activities under **Something Else To Do** that are optional and are intended to further reinforce the concepts introduced in the lesson. One such activity is playing the Memory Game using the **vocabulary words**, which the student will be shown throughout the book. The vocabulary

words and definitions for the Memory Game can be found at the back of this *Activity Book* beginning on page 105. They may be removed and kept together for further use. The

teacher may choose to use these cards as a fun way to learn the vocabulary words.

Teacher and student can decide how many cards they want to use at a time, gradually adding more cards to the game once previous vocabulary words are mastered.



Finally, **Further Study** is an optional activity that is meant to be a platform to further research and study of people, places, and concepts. Often the Internet is recommended, including books and suggested visits to the library, museum, zoo, and so forth.

May the Lord Jesus Christ help the student gain an appreciation for the work of God in his heart, family, church, society, and world.

And the second is like it: **‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’** On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.”

- ✎ Learn the meaning of the vocabulary word “selfish.” Add the word **selfish** to your Memory Game.
- ✎ Think of different ways you can serve someone in your family. Choose one way to serve, and then serve one family member this week.


FURTHER STUDY:

- ✎ Read Luke 10:30–37. This story is called the parable of the Good Samaritan.
 - What happened to the man who went down from Jerusalem to Jericho?
 - Who came by first? What did he do to help the man?
 - Who came by second? What did he do to help the man?
 - Who came by third? What did he do to help the man?
 - What did the Good Samaritan do the next day when he had to leave?
 - Which one was a neighbor to the man who fell among the thieves?
 - How does this parable help us understand Mark 12:33?
- ✎ As time permits, you may choose to go over other examples in the Bible of people who served others.
 - Joseph serves Potiphar (Genesis 39:1–6)
 - Ruth serves her mother-in-law, Naomi (Ruth 1:15–18; 2:11, 12)
 - Jesus serves the disciples by washing their feet (John 13:1–5)
 - The early church in Acts (Acts 2:42–47)




LESSON 31 Activities

- ☛ Look at some ice cubes; do they feel cold? See what comes from the teakettle; what is it called? (*steam*) Then turn on the water from the faucet. All three of these are water, but they have different forms—solid, gas, and liquid.
- ☛ In the same way, God shows Himself to us as the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. He is called the Trinity—one God, but three Persons.
- ☛ Fill in the other two Persons of the Trinity. (*Answers: Holy Spirit, Son*)

- ☛ Learn Matthew 3:16–17 (NKJV). Memorize the words in **bold**.



(Answers: live, die)





- ❧ Learn the meaning of the vocabulary word “bride.” Add the word **bride** to your Memory Game.


FURTHER STUDY:

LESSON 35 Activities

So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.




✎ Memorize Luke 18:16 (NKJV).

- ☛ Learn the meaning of the vocabulary word “honor.” Add the word **honor** to your Memory Game.


