

The C Chord



Use finger 3 to press the 1st string at the 3rd fret. If you have any trouble holding finger 3 down to play the C chord, place fingers 1 and 2 on the 1st and 2nd frets behind finger 3 until you are able to play with just finger 3.







Practice Tip

To change quickly from C⁷ to F in the last two measures, move your 1st finger to the 2nd string—that's not very far—and then put your 2nd finger on the 4th string.










Remember to move your 1st finger to the 2nd string and then put your 2nd finger on the 4th string to play the F chord on the next beat.




