### **WINGS**

Fold your wings in the center to give them a little shape. Slide the ribbon ends through the slots on the wings. Tie the ribbons in a bow to secure the wings. Adjust and re-tie the wings as needed.



Set your crown or flower hat on top of your fairy. Adjust to fit, use the included sticky dots to hold it in place.

## **FASHION SHOW**

Try out your fairy fashions on your 11+ inch (28+ cm) dolls and little plush pets. To adjust to fit, tighten or loosen the ribbons on the skirt and tops as needed. Use a little sticky dot or a bobby pin to hold the crown in place as needed.

Save any leftover materials for touch up and repairs. Spot clean your fairy fashions with a damp cloth.

#### **GETTING STARTED**

The glue and glitter glue included in your kit are washable. For best results cover your work surface and clean up any messes right away.

# FAIRY FASHIONS

You will design and make tulle skirts, lace-up tops, fairy wings and crowns. Follow the directions carefully, so you have enough to make 5 complete outfits. You can use the glitter glue to add a little sparkle wherever you like.

Lay out all the supplies on your work surface: Manneguin, Sketch Book, Stencil, Markers, Scissors, Skirt Fabric, Fairy Tops, Fairy Fabric, Sequins, Tulle Ribbon, Lacing needle, Glue, Glitter Glue, Rhinestones and Fashion accessories.

## FAIRY SKETCHBOOK

Helpful Hint - trace your stencil designs with a pencil first, that way if you make a mistake you can erase it. Use the markers, stencil and sketch book to dream up your own fairy fashions. Give your fairy a name and write a little story about her.






### Cut tulle to this length

## **SKIRTS**


Select your skirt fabric. Using the guide above, measure and cut 10 pieces. Avoid stretching the fabric as you measure. If you want a multi-colored skirt, you can switch colors, just make sure you end up with 10 pieces all the same size.



Select a piece of ribbon and lay it on your work surface.

Helpful Hint! Tape the ribbon ends to your work surface, keeping it loose in the middle. This will hold it in place while you create the skirt.






Fold one piece of tulle in half and place the looped end under vour ribbon.



Slide the 2 loose ends of the tulle through the loop. Pull the ends of the tulle to tighten it onto the ribbon.



Continue folding and looping until you have all 10 pieces attached to the ribbon.



## TUTU (a shorter, fuller skirt)

You can also tie the fabric around the ribbon in a knot. Use your scissors to trim the fabric ends to create a tutu. Measure your tutu against the mannequin to decide how much to trim.



When the skirt is complete, use your glue to attach flowers, rhinestones and leaves.

## **TOPS**

Select a felt piece. Place it on a piece of paper with the self-adhesive side facing up. Peel off the release paper.

#### **Design Option #1**





Sprinkle the adhesive with the heart or star sequins. Press them into place. Shake the top to remove any loose pieces.

Use the paper to return the leftover sequins to the bag.

## Design Option #2







Lay one of the decorative fabric squares over the adhesive. Press to secure. Trim away any extra fabric with your scissors.

Use your glue to add more decorations like flowers, leaves and rhinestones.

Set it aside to dry.



#### **WINGS**

Select a wing and lay it on your work surface. Decorate it with glue, rhinestones, glitter glue – whatever you like! Allow it to dry.







#### **FAIRY CROWNS**

Use the bud branches, ivy and large flowers to make little fairy crowns and fairy hats. Measure them against the mannequin head, then bend, twist and tie them into shape. Use a little glue to add flowers or rhinestones. Set them aside to dry.



## ALL DRESSED UP!

When all the pieces are completely dry, it's time to dress your mannequin!




### **SKIRT**


Tie it onto your mannequin in a bow. Trim the ribbon ends as needed.

### **FAIRY TOP**


You will lace up the top using the plastic needles and a piece of ribbon-just like lacing a shoe! Note to parents - Younger children may need help with this step.



Thread each ribbon end onto a needle.



With the decorated side facing down, thread the ribbon through the bottom holes as shown. Keep the ribbon even on each side.



ribbon loose, and straighten it as you go. When you reach the top, remove the needles.





Place your top over the mannequin. Starting at the bottom, pull the ribbons to tighten the top, adjusting as needed. (do not pull too hard or the holes may tear)

You will use the ribbon ends for attaching the wings.
