7.	List some of the problems that convinced the Pilgrims to move from the Netherlands to New England.
8.	Who were the Strangers? Why did so many Strangers accompany the Pilgrims aboard Mayflower?
9.	To which group would you have liked to belong, the Strangers or the Pilgrims? Why?
10.	Name the leaky ship that forced the Pilgrims to turn back twice.
11.	Name the New England peninsula whose shape resembles a fishhook.
12.	Name the sound that lies between Martha's Vineyard, Nantucket Island and Cape Cod.
13.	Why did rogue English sea captain Thomas Hunt lure a number of Wampanoag and Nauset, including Squanto, aboard his ship?

- 14. Name the agreement the Pilgrims and Strangers wrote and signed just before going ashore in New England for the first time.
- 15. Describe the two surprising new powers the *Mayflower* pioneers claimed for themselves in this agreement.



- 16. How did the Pilgrims upset the Nauset people when they first landed on Cape Cod?
- 17. Name the nearly-naked brave who surprised the Pilgrims by striding into Plymouth's new common house and boldly saying in English, "Welcome, Englishmen!"
- 18. List some of the skills Squanto taught the Pilgrims.
- 19. List some traditional USA Thanksgiving foods that were not on the menu at the Pilgrims' first Thanksgiving.

BONUS QUESTION/ACTIVITY

The earliest and most complete record of the founding of Plymouth Colony comes from "Of Plymouth Plantation," a journal written by long-time Plymouth Governor William Bradford. Long after Bradford died, his original journal disappeared for about 75 years. When did it disappear, and why? Where did the journal resurface?
