Shake your snow globe and watch it snow on your winter scene. Be sure to hold the base and dome when shaking.

Add your Creativity For Kids™ sticker to the bottom of your snow globe.

Display - Place your snow globes on the clear plastic trays provided. In case of accidental leakage, do not display your globes on wood or any surface that may be damaged by water. These globes also look great without the water!



As with any handcrafted item, your snow globes may change over time. This is a normal part of the crafting process.

CREATE 3 WINTER WONDERLANDS!

Note: You will need to divide your supplies so you have enough materials to make all 3 snow globes. For best results, plan out your designs before you begin. Refer to the box for ideas and inspiration.

Place the base on your work station with the shallow side facing up. This is the side you will decorate. **Do not decorate the side with the removable stopper.**

Mixing Clay to Create New Colors:

Red + Yellow = Orange

Yellow + Blue = Green

Red + Yellow + Blue = Brown
Blue + White = Light Blue

Note: You may need to wash your hands when switching colors of clay.

Cover the base of your snow globe with a thin layer of clay. Be sure to leave enough clay for your other 2 snow globes. Push the clay evenly to the edge of the base. This will help seal the globe so water won't leak out.

- Flip the base over and remove the stopper. Using a clay tool, clear the clay out of the hole and replace the stopper. Do not place clay over the hole when decorating. This is where the water will be added later.
- Decorate your scene by making clay trees, a snowman, presents, candy canes - anything vou can imagine.

Use your tools to make hash marks on the bottom of the clav pieces to hold them together. You can also use your tools to help smear and smudge them firmly into the base clay.







Presents

A rectangle of clay can become a present. Roll a thin rope of clay to create a ribbon.






Tree

Form a green cone to create a tree. Add balls of colored clay to create ornaments and a base.















Two balls of white clay can become the body of a snowman. Add thin ropes of clay for the arms and nose. Add balls of colored clay for the eyes and buttons.


Candy Cane

Roll a thin rope of red clay and a thin rope of white clay - twist them together to form a candy cane.













Wipe away any clay from where the globe meets the base and add a line of glue around the seam. Place snow globes on the clear plastic trays provided and let dry for 1-2 hours.



Remove the stopper from the bottom of the base and place the funnel in the hole. Use a small stream of cool water to fill the base. Once it is filled replace the stopper. For a crystal clear snow globe, try using bottled or distilled water.





It is best to work over a sink and ask an adult for help as needed. Have some paper towels handy to clean up any drips.
