

- On the left-side map, label ENGLAND, IRELAND, FRANCE, the NETHERLANDS and SCOTLAND. Also label the IRISH SEA, NORTH SEA, BALTIC SEA, ENGLISH CHANNEL and STRAIT OF DOVER. Label the ATLANTIC OCEAN on both maps.
- Label LEIDEN, HOLLAND, where the Pilgrims lived after they first left England.
- When the Pilgrims decided to establish their own colony in NORTH AMERICA, their first step was to sail from LEIDEN through the STRAIT OF DOVER to a stop at SOUTHHAMPTON, ENGLAND. Label SOUTHHAMPTON.
- The Pilgrims were on their way to North America when Speedwell sprung bad leaks, forcing them to return to DARTMOUTH, ENGLAND for repairs. Label DARTMOUTH.
- On the right-side map, label the Pilgrims' first landing site: PROVIDENCETOWN HARBOR. From there, the Pilgrims crossed CAPE COD BAY to the first permanent English settlement in New England: PLYMOUTH on PLYMOUTH BAY. Label CAPE COD BAY, PLYMOUTH and PLYMOUTH BAY.
- Label BOSTON, where John Winthrop will arrive in 1630 to establish Massachusetts Bay Colony. Also label MASSACHUSETTS BAY and BUZZARDS BAY.

CHALLENGE: Label ELIZABETH ISLANDS, MARTHA'S VINEYARD, VINEYARD SOUND, NANTUCKET SOUND and NANTUCKET.

GEOGRAPHY NEED TO KNOW: Location of the Strait of Dover. Locations of Massachusetts Bay, Cape Cod Bay, Plymouth Bay, Buzzards Bay, Boston and Plymouth.
