## Paper Mesh

The fantastic texture of this paper is reminiscent of burlap fabric and provides a fabulous base for painting, sewing or stitching art projects! Use this paper to develop fine motor skills while creating beautiful take-home art. Tip: A bit of glue around the edge of a sheet prevents fraying!



Practice sewing skills by incorporating buttons and beads into your design. Color or paint your design. Once the paint is dry, sew buttons, beads or short straws to the paper mesh to give your design a relief quality.

Try sewing finger puppets, potpourri satchels, bracelets and change purses.

Ideas: Create a crossstitch craft! Draft a design in pencil. It can be an abstract design, like waves of color or a representational design like a butterfly. Using our Roylco R5601 Plastic Lacing Needles and colorful yarn, make a line of slanted stitches from left to right inside one area of your design. Then cross over the stitches from right to left to create cross stitched color.

Make textured

paintings! This paper makes painting with fingers or bushes a sensory experience. Let young children explore the texture with their fingers. Older children will enjoy painting this paper with our Roylco R54466 Junior Paint Spritzer. Tip: Use newspaper or our Roylco R7512 Fingerpaint "No Mess" Tray to keep the activity neat.
