Using <u>The Prairie Primer</u>:

There are nine units in the <u>Primer</u>—one corresponding to each nine "Little House" books. The <u>Primer</u> follows, on average, a book-a-month schedule. Approximately twenty-five pages of reading are assigned from the "Little House" books daily in addition to other suggested reading. When the daily plan is followed, the entire curriculum can be completed in one school year. *But it is emphasized that you follow a plan best suited to your family's pace.* The daily reading and activities can be halved, and the plan completed in two
