Rules for the 2024 RRC Summer Book Contest

Creating Your Poetry Book contest entry

Learn how to submit your book!



- Open to US residents only. Ages 7-18 as of Jan 1, 2024.
- One author per kit. One contest entry per kit, per contest year.

Each kit makes one 7x9" hardcover book. Design the front cover and all 18 book pages . Keep within the provided borderlines of your cover page and book pages. Authors can choose to include a dedication page (which is additional to the 18 required pages). This option is on the order form in your kit.
Each author must hand write their own book . Handwriting should be dark and legible to be read in printed form. Your written pages will be printed to accommodate the final book size (7x9), so larger, legible print works best.
Each author must illustrate their own book. Colored pencils or markers work well. 3D or digital art is not accepted. Include poetry and at least one illustration/embellishment per 2-pg spread . Page 1 is an individual, right-facing page. The first full spread starts with page 2 on left, then page 3 on right.
This year, you may write poetry on the kit pages as you wish. If you need a full-page text option, a fully lined text page is available on our web site to print out and use. Copy the kit pages as needed for practice and to create your book's final pages.
Reference the judging rubric as you create your book. We use this to judge each contest entry. Sorry; we cannot share scores with contestants.
 To officially enter the contest, we must receive an email with the following information by Friday Sept 6th, 2024, 5pm CT to Rainbow Resource Center at

Tracking number found at the bottom of the order form inside your Lulu Jr. book kit. Looks like this: SU ###### XX.
Your contest entries will be confirmed with a Rainbow Resource email and a follow-up confirmation letter. If you do not receive our email confirmation by Sept 6, please contact us to ensure that your child has been officially entered in this year's contest.
Mailing Your Entry
Physical pages should be postmarked to Lulu Jr. by Sept 6, 2024 , using the kit's pre-paid envelope. We highly recommend making a color scanned copy of your book for reference until you receive your printed copy.
Your shipping envelope should be stamped with "RRC" in the lower front left corner. If not, please write these letters in the lower front left corner. These letters ensure Lulu will process your book quickly.
Do not send RRC your book in any form . Judges read a digital version of each book provided by Lulu, Jr.
• Winners will be announced via our social media at noon CST, Friday, November 15. The winning book is typically available for purchase shortly after the announcement
