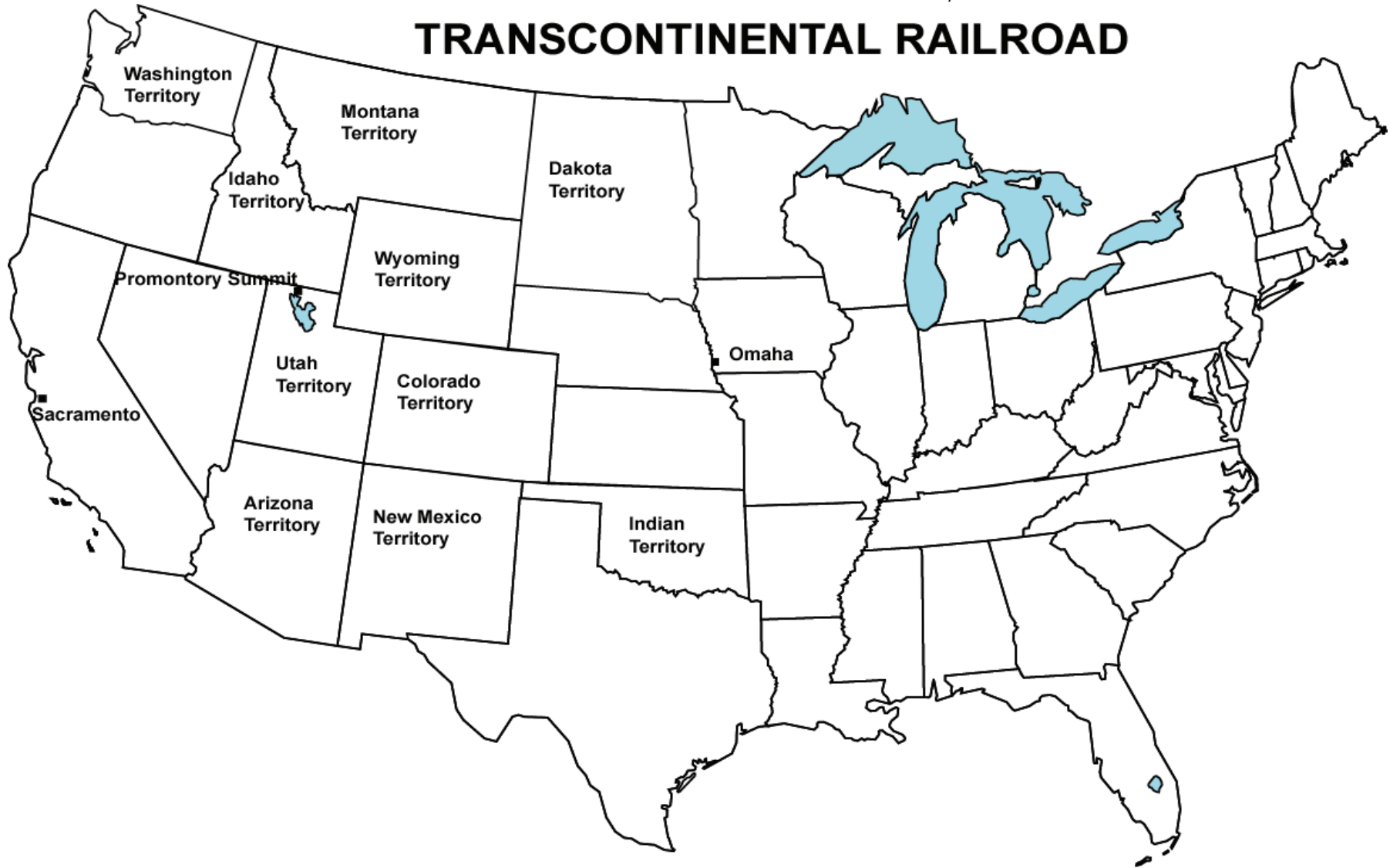


TRANSCONTINENTAL RAILROAD



- Label the 38 states that were part of the UNITED STATES in 1868.
- Label the bodies of water: GULF OF MEXICO, PACIFIC OCEAN, ATLANTIC OCEAN and THE FIVE GREAT LAKES.
- Railroads were everywhere from Maine to Florida and as far west as Kansas. Circle KANSAS in red. This was as far as anyone could travel on the railroad.
- The Transcontinental Railroad began in two places; OMAHA, NEBRASKA and SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA.
- The Union Pacific railroad crews built the track from OMAHA to PROMONTORY SUMMIT, UTAH. Draw the track and a tiny train on it that says: '119'
- The Central Pacific railroad crews built the track from SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA TO PROMONTORY SUMMIT, UTAH. Draw the track and a tiny train on it that says: 'Jupiter'
- On May 10, 1869, the tracks met at Promontory, Utah. Draw a golden spike over PROMONOTORY SUMMIT.
