



- Label the bodies of water.
- Label Canaan. Label Ur. Label Haran. Label Babylon.
- Hammurabi's empire stretched from Sippar to Ur in Southern Mesopotamia. Write a large H over this area.
- When Shamshi-Adad first came to power (see Companion), he began in the town of Ekallatum. Write an **orange number "1"** over Ekallatum.
- Eventually Shamshi-Adad gained control over a triangular section of Northern Mesopotamia: Assur, Nineveh and Mari. Connect those city dots, making an **orange triangle**. Write **"ASSYRIA"** in the center of the triangle.
- Shamshi-Adad traded with the people in Anatolia (modern day Turkey) and Syria. Using a map or globe, label Anatolia and Syria.
- Hammurabi moved into Shamshi-Adad's kingdom after he died. Draw **arrows** from Hammurabi's kingdom into Shamshi-Adad's kingdom.
