## Map out your grading system:

Questions to consider...

- What percentage will you use for your grading scale?
- How will you grade? Possibilities:
  - Only tests and projects.
  - Add small percentage for daily assignments and/or participation, attitude, creativity, or thoroughness.
  - Writing percentage for organization, content, grammar, and research or effort.
- How will you grade? Possibilities:
  - Did you student master the content for an A?
  - Did they do pretty good work but wasn't wholeheartedly involved for a B?
  - Did they do a fair job but overall performance wasn't up to par for a C?
